Active substance/product type combinations for which, following a redefinition of the active substance, all participants have withdrawn pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007

In accordance with Article 11(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007, the Commission shall inform Member States and stakeholders if a situation arises where, as regards a particular existing active substance/product type combination, all the participants have withdrawn or no dossier has been received within the time period specified in Article 9(2) to that Regulation. That information shall also be made public by electronic means.

During the review of some active substance, it appeared that the identity of the substance under evaluation did not correspond to the original one as provided in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007. The identity of the substance therefore had to be re-defined in the course of the review, with the consequence that the substance/product type combinations that are listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007 are not covered by the approval decision.

Similarly, the scope of some product types were re-defined in the course of the review, with the consequence that substance/product type combinations that are listed in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007 are not covered by the approval decision.

As no dossier has been received and evaluated for these substance/product type combinations covered by the original definition as provided for in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1451/2007, the support for those combinations is considered as withdrawn, and Commission hereby publishes a withdrawal notice in accordance with Article 11(2).

The following list contains these active substance/product type combinations.

Within three months of the publication of this notice, a producer, formulator, association or other person wishing to take over the role of participant as regards the existing active substance/product type combination shall inform the Commission accordingly.

Within the same time period, Member States may indicate to the Commission that they are interested to take over the role of a participant for one or more of the listed active substance/product type combinations.

Where the Commission receives no response within three months, a decision shall be taken not to approve these substances under Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 for the product type(s) concerned, and biocidal products containing those substances for the product type(s) concerned will have to be withdrawn from the market.
